2012 “Fellers” Cake Decorating Contest Rules

1. Cakes should be delivered to EK gymnasium on Saturday, February 25, 2012 between 3:00 and 4:00 pm.
2. A Cub Scout and older male must bake and decorate Cakes. (If there is no father in the family, an uncle, older brother or neighbor can help. Moms only allowed as a last resort.)
3. Cake mixes and icing mixes may be used.
4. Entire creation must be edible, including all decorations.
5. All cakes should have a title or name, to be shown as part of the cake decoration or on a card attached to the cake. Cakes will be numbered for judging purposes.
6. Recommend cakes be placed on a disposable plate or tray.
7. All cakes will be judged and prizes awarded in the following categories:
 - Judge’s Choice (Grand Prize)
 - Most Original Creation
 - Most Suitable Named
 - Biggest Cake
 - Tallest Cake
 - Flattest Cake
 - Best Cub Scout Theme
 - Yummiest Looking
8. Cakes will be used for the banquet dessert.
